Each year there are more than **130,000** new diagnoses of multiple myeloma worldwide²

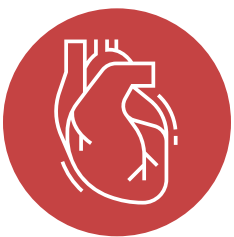

This disease is most frequently diagnosed in people between **65—74** years old²

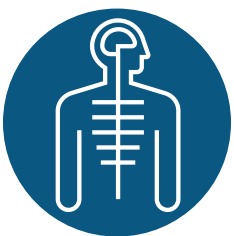

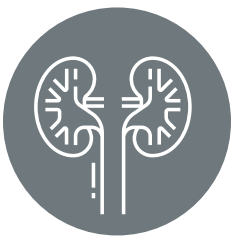
SIGNS and SYMPTOMS³



Shortness of breath or evidence of **heart** or kidney failure



Nervous system disorders



Persistent tiredness due to anemia or **kidney** failure



Recurrent unexplained infections, such as **pneumonia (lungs)**



Bone pain that is persistent or recurrent, and fractures
